

Job Description: Web Designer

Summary: The Web designer will be responsible for supporting existing infrastructure as well as develop new technologies for a Federal Government Agency.

The ideal candidate must display excellent written and oral skills with demonstrated interpersonal and organization abilities. A candidate for this position must be able to work in a varied, fast paced environment. Flexibility and tolerance is a necessity. Limited travel required.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities: include the following. Other duties may be assigned as required.

- Design, build, and manage web sites using Cold Fusion, SQL, C++, HTML, CGI and JavaScript.
- Code files and information to post on Government websites that comply with Section 508 of the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- Maintain and enhance existing Web applications.
- Perform complete testing of Web applications engaging users as necessary.
- Conduct all user acceptances testing, and report results.
- Design and implement user-driven templates, databases and interfaces for ease of use.
- Develop database-driven Web interfaces for rapid, real-time information sharing.
- Develop external Web portals allowing users to input and retrieve accurate information.
- Candidate must be a team player and willing to teach and to learn.

The Ideal candidate will also possess the following skills:

- Able to work independently and efficiently to meet deadlines.
- Able to promptly answer support related email, phone calls and other electronic communications.
- Self motivated, detail-oriented and organized.
- Experience with hardware and software issues.
- Proficient in Internet related applications such as E-Mail clients, FTP clients and Web Browsers.
- Excellent communication (oral and written), interpersonal, organizational, and presentation skills.
